## **Feast of St Paul of the Cross**

Wednesday of this week is the Feast of St Paul of the Cross, Founder of the Passionists and Patron Saint of our Church and Parish. Near the end of his life, St Paul of the Cross said: 'I place all my hope and confidence in the Passion of Jesus. Our Lord knows well that I have laboured all of my life to love him myself, and to make others love him.'

### 1916 Exhibition at the Pro-Cathedral

'Ministry, Advocacy and Compassion' is the name of a new exhibition that takes you into the heart of the Easter Rising and examines the role of the Catholic Church in 1916. Historical documents relating to the Rising will be available to view for the first time, including accounts left by priests who risked their lives while attending to the wounded and dying. The exhibition also includes an audio player whereby the visitor can listen to stories from witnesses of key events. A key part of the exhibition, the interactive touchscreen features hundreds of never-before-seen documents, all relating to the 1916 Rising, that were digitized by the Dublin Diocesan Archive and the Irish Capuchin Archives. The exhibition is open from 1.30 to 5.30 pm daily at St Kevin's Chapel in the Pro-Cathedral, 83 Marlborough Street, Dublin. Admission is free.
