Diaconate Ordination

Next Sunday at the 11.00 Mass we will welcome Archbishop Diarmuid Martin who is coming to Mount Argus to ordain Brother Aidan O'Kane as a Deacon. This is a special moment in the life of our community; the last deacon to be ordained in Mount Argus was Father Frank Trias in 2015. For Brother Aidan, ordination as a deacon is part of his journey towards the priesthood, as it was for Father Frank; he hopes to be ordained as a priest in May 2020. Please keep Brother Aidan in your prayers as he prepares for this ordination. All are welcome to take part in the ordination Mass next Sunday.

<u>November Masses for Deceased Passionists:</u> The Annual Mass for Deceased Passionists will be celebrated on Saturday, 16 November at 11.00 am.

<u>November Lists</u> are available on the tables at the back of the church. There are three ways you can submit your November List of deceased loved ones whom you want to be remembered in November Masses. Lists can be placed in the box provided at the back of the Church at Sunday Masses; you can place them in the collection basket as the collection is taken up and the collectors will separate them from the ordinary collection, or you may hand them in at the monastery reception. The lists are placed beneath the Altar during the month of November.

<u>Parish Council Report:</u> Following the nomination and election process which took place over the summer, we have two new members of the Pastoral Council: Maria Diskin and Sister Ann Thomas (Little Sisters of the Assumption). The Council has been looking at how the new St Charles Centre will function as a visitor centre for pilgrims and a resource for our Church. We also looked at other existing facilities (the Upper Room and Middle Room, the Parish Community Centre on Lower Kimmage Road, the meeting rooms in the monastery, St Paul's Hall which is used by the Scouts) and how these various rooms and buildings participate in the pastoral life of the parish. The Council is keen to invite new volunteers to help with parish activities and is planning an event to promote this. We hope to have a Parish Assembly in the Spring.
