Diaconate Ordination

Today at the 11.00 Mass we welcome Archbishop Diarmuid Martin who is coming to Mount Argus to ordain Brother Aidan O'Kane CP as a Deacon. We also welcome Brother Aidan's family and friends who have travelled from the Glens of Antrim and beyond to take part in the celebration, and we remember his deceased parents, Patrick and Nuala. For Brother Aidan, ordination as a deacon is part of his journey towards the priesthood; he hopes to be ordained as a priest in May 2020. Please keep Brother Aidan in your prayers as he begins his ministry as a deacon and prepares for ordination to the priesthood. Please remember also to pray for all those who are discerning a vocation to the priesthood or the religious life. Here is a vocation prayer:

Jesus, you gave your life on the Cross so that we could share in God's own life and know his love for us. May the love that flows from the Cross transform our hearts, so that we can bring your love and compassion to those whose lives we touch, especially those who are suffering.

Give the light of your Holy Spirit to those young people who have received the grace of a Passionist vocation. Inspire them to give their lives as Passionist priests, brothers or sisters, keeping the Memory of your Passion alive in their own hearts and in the hearts of others.

May Mary, who stood by the Cross, be their example, and may Saint Paul of the Cross be their guide. Amen. World Day of the Poor is celebrated in the Catholic Church today. This year's theme is "The hope of the poor will not perish for ever" (Ps 9:19). Pope Francis writes about this theme: "These words of the Psalm remain timely.
