Our special Family Mass for Advent takes place today (Sunday, 22 December) at 11.00 am. Christmas Confessions: On Monday, 23 December, confessions will be from 10.30 to 11.30 am and from 4.00 to 6.00 pm. On Christmas Eve (Tuesday, 24 December), confessions will be from 10.30 am to 1.00 pm and from 2.00 pm until 6.00 pm. After that, there will be no confessions in the church until Saturday, 4 January when normal confession times resume.

Times of Christmas Masses: On Christmas Eve, 24 December, there will be the usual morning Mass at 10.00. On Christmas Eve, there will also be the Vigil Mass of Christmas at 6.15 pm, and the Mass of the Nativity at 9.00 pm, with Carols from 8.30 pm and the Blessing of the Crib before the Mass. On Christmas Day, the Dawn Mass will be at 8.00 am and the Day Mass will be celebrated at 11.00 am. (This is the Family Mass with the Children's Nativity Play.) Please note that there will be no evening Mass on Christmas Day.

<u>Christmas Play:</u> The children of Mount Argus Parish dramatise the Christmas Story each year at the 11.00 Mass on Christmas Day. There is a rehearsal today after the 11.00 am Mass. All children are welcome.

<u>Feast of Saint Charles of Mount Argus:</u> Normally we celebrate the Feast of Saint Charles on 5 January. This year, however, 5 January is a Sunday, the Second Sunday of Christmas, so we will commemorate the anniversary of Saint Charles's death at the Sunday Masses. Because this commemoration of Saint Charles occurs on a Sunday, there will be no "Transitus" Vigil of Prayer at the Tomb of Saint Charles this year. We are very blessed at Mount Argus to have our own saint, Saint Charles, who celebrated Mass, heard confessions and blessed the sick in this church, and who continues to intercede for those who need healing and hope today.
