The Christmas Crib

Last Sunday Pope Francis published a letter to the whole Church on what he called "the enchanting image of the Christmas Crib". He writes: With this Letter, I wish to encourage the beautiful family tradition of preparing the nativity scene in the days before Christmas, but also the custom of setting it up in the workplace, in schools, hospitals, prisons and town squares. Great imagination and creativity is always shown in employing the most diverse materials to create small masterpieces of beauty. As children, we learn from our parents and grandparents to carry on this joyful tradition.... It is my hope that this custom will never be lost and that, wherever it has fallen into disuse, it can be rediscovered and revived.

Bambinelli Sunday: Next Sunday is what in Italy is known as "Bambinelli Sunday" when the little figures of the baby Jesus which people will place in their Christmas Cribs are blessed. We invite children – and adults too – to bring the baby Jesus figure from their Crib to the 11.00 Family Mass next Sunday, 15 December, when there will be a special blessing for the figures of the Christ-child (the "Bambinelli").

Children's Liturgy of the Word and Family Mass during Advent: During Advent, there is Children's Liturgy of the Word each Sunday at the 11.00 Mass. Our next special Family Mass with the children taking part in the readings and prayers will take place on the Fourth Sunday of Advent, 22 December at 11.00 am.
