Ash Wednesday at Mount Argus

The Season of Lent begins on Wednesday of this week, 26 February. Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence. A leaflet containing all the Mass, service and special event times is available at the back of the Church. There will be an extra Mass on weekdays during Lent (from Monday to Friday) at 7.00 am, beginning on Ash Wednesday.

Forty Hours Adoration: As is usual at Mount Argus, the Forty Hours Adoration begins on Ash Wednesday. Adoration will begin after the 10.00 am Mass and will continue throughout the day, ending with Prayer and Benediction from 7.30 to 8.00 pm. On Thursday, 27 February, the Adoration will resume after the 10.00 am Mass and continue until Prayer and Benediction from 7.30 to 8.00 pm. Do try to join us for this evening time of meditative Prayer and Benediction on 26 and 27 February, as a way of beginning Lent in a reflective spirit. During the Forty Hours, there will be the usual evening Mass at 6.15.

<u>Forty Hours Adoration "Chart":</u> To ensure that there is always someone praying before the Blessed Sacrament during the Forty Hours Adoration, a chart has been placed at the back of the Church this weekend. You are invited to sign up for a half hour of prayer during the Forty Hours Adoration.

<u>Trocaire Lenten Boxes:</u> Lenten Boxes for Trocaire are available on the tables at the back of the Church. <u>Passionist Feast Day:</u> On Thursday of this week, we celebrate the Feast of St Gabriel of Our Lady of Sorrows, Passionist student, who died on 27 February 1862.

<u>Day of Prayer:</u> The Catholic Church in Ireland holds an annual Day of Prayer for Survivors and Victims of Sexual Abuse. This year's Day of Prayer will take place on Friday 28 February, the first Friday of Lent.
