#### **Service of Light**

During the month of November we pray in a special way for all those who have died, asking God to bring them to the fullness of life and peace, and asking him also to give strength and consolation to their families and friends. At Mount Argus it is our custom to celebrate, on the first Saturday of November, a "Service of Light" Mass in remembrance of those who have died during the past year. This remembrance Mass will be celebrated on Saturday, 7 November at 11.00 am. During the Mass, we will read out the names of those whose funerals have taken place in the last year, and a candle will be lit in memory of each person. Because Ireland is now at Level 5 in the Government's response to the Coronavirus Pandemic, the Church will not be open to the public for this Mass. However, you can follow the Mass at www.churchservices.tv/mountargus **November Lists** are available on the tables at the back of the church so that your deceased loved ones can be remembered in the November Masses. Mass is offered every day during November and once a month throughout the year for those enrolled in our November List of the Dead. Completed lists can be handed in at the monastery. The lists will be placed beneath the Altar and remain there through the month of November. <u>Times of Prayer on the Webcam:</u> The Rosary is prayed after morning Mass on weekdays (Monday to Saturday), except on Fridays when we pray the Stations of the Cross. The Rosary is prayed after morning Mass on weekdays (Monday to Saturday), except on Fridays when we have Stations of the Cross after morning Mass.

The Church is open for personal prayer at these hours:

Saturday - 12.00 noon to 5.00 pm; Sunday - 12.00 noon to 3.00 pm; Monday to Friday - 11.00 am to 5.00 pm There are no Confessions and no Eucharistic Adoration at Mount Argus during this time.

Meanwhile, let's continue to pray for one another and to remember especially those who are sick and those who are caring for the sick.
