Year of Saint Joseph

On 8 December 2020 Pope Francis proclaimed a special "Year of St Joseph" for the Catholic Church. St Joseph, whose feast day is 19 March, had been named as Patron of the Universal Church one hundred and fifty years before that date. In a letter entitled "With a Father's Heart", which he wrote for the occasion, Pope Francis spoke of St Joseph as "the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence," who nonetheless played "an incomparable role in the history of salvation." Joseph "did not look for shortcuts but confronted reality with open eyes and accepted personal responsibility for it." The Pope wrote that St Joseph "encourages us to accept and welcome others as they are, without exception, and to show special concern for the weak".

Prayer for the Year of St Joseph: On Friday evening we will have a special time of prayer and reflection for the Feast of St Joseph, in this year of St Joseph. This will be available online at 7.30 pm on Friday, 19 March.

Masses for St Patrick's Day: Online Masses for St Patrick's Day will be at 6.15 pm on Tuesday evening (Vigil Mass) and at 11.00 am on Wednesday. There will be no evening Mass or evening prayer service from Mount Argus on St Patrick's Day.

<u>Legion of Mary:</u> The Legion of Mary will hold an online Acies Ceremony of Consecration to Our Lady at Mount Argus next Sunday at 6.00 pm.

<u>Happy Mother's Day:</u> Wherever we are, we can pray today for our Mothers, living or dead, and entrust them to the loving care of Mary, Mother of Jesus and Mother of us all.

Passionist Jubilee Indulgence: In celebration of the Passionist Jubilee Year, Pope Francis has granted a special Jubilee Indulgence to those who visit the Church of St Paul of the Cross at Mount Argus (or any Passionist Church). This Jubilee Indulgence can be received every day in all Passionist churches during the Jubilee Year, which lasts until 1st January 2022. The conditions for the Jubilee Indulgence are: (1) Spiritual participation in the Jubilee celebrations of the Third Centenary of the Foundation of the Passionist Congregation; (2) A serious commitment to conversion confirmed by sacramental confession and participation in the Eucharist; (3) Prayer for the Pope's intentions. The elderly, the infirm and those who cannot leave the house, due to a serious impediment, can gain the Jubilee Indulgence by joining spiritually in the Jubilee celebrations, committing themselves to fulfilling the three conditions (Confession, Holy Communion, Prayer for the Pope's Intentions) as soon as possible.

<u>Pilgrim Visit Leaflet:</u> A leaflet for making a Pilgrim Visit to Mount Argus during the Passionist Jubilee Year is available at the back of the church. The leaflet can be used for private visits to the church by those who wish to gain the Jubilee Indulgence.

<u>Times of Prayer on the Webcam:</u> The Rosary is prayed after morning Mass on weekdays (Monday to Saturday), except on Fridays when we pray the Stations of the Cross. The Blessing with the Relic of St Charles is given after morning Mass on weekdays and after the 11.00 am and 4.00 pm Masses on Sundays.

Saturday Vigil at 6.15 pm Sunday at 8.00 am, 11.00 am and 4.00 pm. Monday to Friday at 10.00 am and 6.15 pm; Saturday morning at 11.00 (with St Charles Novena Prayers).

The Rosary is prayed after morning Mass on weekdays (Monday to Saturday), except on Fridays when we have Stations of the Cross after morning Mass.

The Church will be open for personal prayer at these hours:

Saturday- 12.00 noon to 5.00 pm Sunday – 12.00 noon to 3.00 pm Monday to Friday – 11.00 am to 5.00 pm

There will be no Confessions and no Eucharistic Adoration at Mount Argus until further notice.

Meanwhile, let's continue to pray for one another and to remember especially those who are sick and those who are caring for the sick.
