At the Mass, we will have a blessing of these children and any other babies and young children who are present at the Mass.

The Council looked at the Calendar of events for the parish's Golden Jubilee year which will begin on 24 April with "An Evening of Memories" with Fr Brian D'Arcy. On 12 May, we will have the Gala Concert Premier of Patrick Cassidy's "The Mass" – see below for more information about this special event. On Sunday, 9 June (weather permitting) we will have an outdoor Jubilee Gathering after the 11.00 am Mass which will be the last special Family Mass before the summer holidays. A date for your diary later in the year is Sunday, 3 November when, at 11.00 am, Archbishop Farrell will celebrate the Golden Jubilee Mass of Thanksgiving for Mount Argus Parish.
