The parishes in our partnership are Holy Name (Beechwood Avenue), the Three Patrons (Rathgar), Mary Immaculate, Refuge of Sinners (Rathmines), Our Lady of the Rosary (Harold's Cross) and St Paul of the Cross (Mount Argus).

<u>Special Family Mass and Coffee Morning:</u> Our next special Family Mass, with the children taking part in the readings and the prayer of the faithful, takes place on Sunday, 28 April at 11.00 am. The monthly Coffee Morning will be held after the Family Mass.

At the Mass, we will have a blessing of these children and any other babies and young children who are present at the Mass.
