Charles through the lives of three of his contemporaries: **Blessed Dominic Barberi; Fr. Paul Mary Pakenham, and Fr. Ignatius Spencer.** Picking up on themes from the lives of these characters Fr. Frank CP and the Mount Argus Spirituality Team will lead us each night in prayerful reflection and symbolic action.
