Synod on the Family

Today, Sunday 4th October (Feast of St. Francis of Assisi), there begins in Rome the **Synod on the Vocation and Mission of the Family in the Church and in the Contemporary World**. Its purpose is to formulate guidelines for the pastoral care of persons and the family. Let every prayer group and every individual in our parish make this one of their special prayer intentions during the month of October. The Synod closes on Sunday 25th October.
