National Collection for the Pope's Visit to Ireland

Next Sunday there will be a special National Collection to help defray the costs of the recent World Meeting of Families and the visit of Pope Francis. The overall cost to the Church in Ireland for hosting the World Meeting comes to €19.4m. To date €15.4m has been raised by way of local church collections and by other donations. This leaves us with a deficit of €4m. In his message regarding the collection, Archbishop Martin says: 'While I am acutely conscious of the many financial demands facing families and parishes at this time, all support offered would be greatly appreciated.'
