Holy Thursday, 6 April: 10.00 am Morning Prayer; 7.30 pm Mass of the Lord's Supper

Good Friday, 7 April: 10.00 am Morning Prayer; 3.00 pm Liturgy of the Passion and Death of the Lord;
7.30 pm Seven Last Words

Holy Saturday, 8 April: 10.00 am Morning Prayer; 9.00 pm Easter Vigil Mass

Easter Sunday, 9 April: Mass at 8.00 am, 11.00 am and 4.00 pm

Easter Monday, 10 April: Mass at 11.00 am

Tuesday to Friday, 11 to 14 April: Mass at 10.00 am only (No evening Mass)

Saturday, 15 April: Mass at 11.00 am; Vigil Mass at 6.15 pm

Holy Week Confessions: Wednesday, 13 April: 11.00 – 11.30 am; 4.00 – 4.30 pm. Holy Thursday, 14 April: 10.30 – 12.00 am; 4.00 – 5.00 pm. Good Friday, 15 April: 10.30 – 11.30 am; after the 3.00 pm Service; after the Seven Last Words. Holy Saturday, 16 April: 10.30 – 11.30 am; 4.00 – 5.30 pm. After Holy Saturday, there will be no confessions in the church until Saturday, 15 April.

Holy Land Collection: At the services on Good Friday, there will be a special collection for the Church in the Holy Land.

The Sacred Triduum: On Holy Thursday, the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper will be celebrated at 7.30 pm. Adoration after Mass will continue at the Altar of Repose until 9.00 pm. On Good Friday, the Liturgy of the Passion and Death of the Lord, with Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion, will be celebrated in the Church at 3.00 pm. On Good Friday evening at 7.30 pm, we will have the Seven Last Words: seven meditations on the words of Jesus on the Cross, with music by the Male Voice Choir of An Garda Síochána. On Holy Saturday night, the Easter Vigil Mass and Celebration of the Resurrection will begin at 9.00 pm. Masses on Easter Sunday will be at the usual times: 8.00 am, 11.00 am, 4.00 pm.

Morning Prayer – Thursday, Friday, Saturday: On Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday, there will be Morning Prayer in the Church at 10.00 am. There will be no 10.00 am or 6.15 pm Mass on those days.

Way of the Cross: The annual Way of the Cross through the Phoenix Park will take place on Good Friday, 15 April. Led by Archbishop Dermot Farrell, it will begin at the Wellington Monument at 12.00 noon and proceed to the Papal Cross. All are welcome.

Eucharistic Adoration will take place on Wednesday of this week from after the 10.00 am Mass until 6.00 pm. There will be no Eucharistic Adoration on Good Friday or on Wednesday or Friday of Easter Week.

St Vincent de Paul Advocate Collection: The Society of St Vincent de Paul has now advised that the Advocate collection for Sunshine House, usually held on Palm Sunday, will not take place this year as the facility is currently closed so that essential health and safety refurbishments can take place.

Trocaire Lenten Boxes can be left in the basket at Mass or handed in to the monastery.

Dublin Diocesan Pilgrimage to Knock – Saturday, 29 April 2023: A bus has been organised for our deanery to travel to Knock on Saturday, 29 April as part of the Dublin Diocesan Pilgrimage to Knock which will be led by Archbishop Dermot Farrell. The bus will depart from Our Lady Immaculate Refuge of Sinners Church in Rathmines at 7.30 am and will leave Knock at 5.30 that evening. If required, the bus will also stop at St Agnes Parish Crumlin at 7.45 am to collect pilgrims and will drop off there on the return journey. There are 48 seats available and the cost of the return journey is €25. This would need to be paid in advance to guarantee a place which will be on a "first come, first served" basis.
