Advent – Preparing for Christmas

The Season of Advent is a time of spiritual preparation for Christmas. You will see that the building of our Christmas crib has already started, preparing the place where the image of the child Jesus will be found on Christmas Day. Perhaps you are already thinking of the Christmas Crib you will place in your home at Christmas. In a letter he wrote in 2019, Pope Francis reflected on the meaning of what he called "the enchanting image of the Christmas Crib". He wrote: I wish to encourage the beautiful family tradition of preparing the nativity scene in the days before Christmas, but also the custom of setting it up in the workplace, in schools, hospitals, prisons and town squares. Great imagination and creativity is always shown in employing the most diverse materials to create small masterpieces of beauty. As children, we learn from our parents and grandparents to carry on this joyful tradition.... It is my hope that this custom will never be lost and that, wherever it has fallen into disuse, it can be rediscovered and revived.

<u>Family Mass for Advent:</u> Our next special Family Mass with the children taking part in the readings and the prayer of the faithful will take place on the Third Sunday of Advent, 17 December at 11.00 am. There will be a Coffee Morning in the Upper Room after this Mass.

<u>Church Cleaning for Christmas:</u> Next Sunday, 17 December, from 5.00 to 6.30 pm, we will be cleaning the Church in preparation for Christmas, We are looking for volunteers to help with this; any help you can give would be very much appreciated. All cleaning material and equipment will be provided.

For Sunday 24 December, Christmas Eve, there will be the usual Sunday Masses: Vigil Mass on Saturday at 6.15 pm; Sunday Masses at 8.00 am, 11.00 am and 4.00 pm. On Christmas Eve, there will also be the Vigil Mass of Christmas at 6.15 pm, and the Mass of the Nativity at 9.00 pm, with Carols from 8.30 pm and the Blessing of the Crib before the Mass. On Christmas Day, the Dawn Mass will be at 8.00 am and the Day Mass (Family Mass) will be celebrated at 11.00 am. Please note that there will be no evening Mass on Christmas Day.
