Good Friday, 29 March: Morning Prayer at 10.00 am; Liturgy of the Passion and Death of the Lord at 3.00 pm; Seven Last Words at 7.30 pm

Holy Saturday, 30 March: Morning Prayer at 10.00 am; Easter Vigil at 9.00 pm

Easter Sunday, 31 March: Mass at 8.00 am, 11.00 am and 4.00 pm

Easter Monday, 1 April: Mass at 11.00 am only (No evening Mass)

Tuesday to Friday, 2 to 5 April: Mass at 10.00 am only (No evening Mass)

Saturday, 6 April: Novena Mass at 11.00 am; Vigil Mass at 6.15 pm

Special Family Mass and Coffee Morning: Our next special Family Mass, with the children taking part in the readings and the prayer of the faithful, takes place today (Sunday) at 11.00 am. The monthly Coffee Morning will be held after the Family Mass.

Holy Week Confessions: Wednesday, 27 March: 11.00 – 11.30 am; 4.00 – 4.30 pm. Holy Thursday, 28 March: 10.30 – 11.30 am; 4.00 – 5.00 pm. Good Friday, 29 March: 10.30 – 11.30 am; after the 3.00 pm Service and after the Seven Last Words. Holy Saturday, 30 March: 10.30 – 11.30 am; 4.00 – 5.30 pm. After Holy Saturday, there will be no confessions in the church until Saturday, 6 April.

Reconciliation Service: Our Partnership of parishes has its Holy Week Celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation in the Church of the Three Patrons, Rathgar on Monday, 25 March at 7.30 pm. Before the service, there will be Stations of the Cross at 7.00 pm.

The Sacred Triduum: On Holy Thursday, the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper will be celebrated at 7.30 pm. Adoration after Mass will continue at the Altar of Repose until 9.00 pm. On Good Friday, the Liturgy of the Passion and Death of the Lord, with Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion, will be celebrated in the Church at 3.00 pm. On Good Friday evening at 7.30 pm, we will have the Seven Last Words: seven meditations on the words of Jesus on the Cross, with music by the Male Voice Choir of An Garda Siochana. On Holy Saturday night, the Easter Vigil Mass and Celebration of the Resurrection will begin at 9.00 pm. Masses on Easter Sunday will be at the usual times: 8.00 am, 11.00 am, 4.00 pm.

Morning Prayer – Thursday, Friday, Saturday: On Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday, there will be Morning Prayer in the Church at 10.00 am. There will be no 10.00 am or 6.15 pm Mass on those days.

Eucharistic Adoration will take place on Wednesday of this week from 4.00 to 6.00 pm. There will be no Eucharistic Adoration on Good Friday or on Wednesday or Friday of Easter Week.

Holy Week and Easter 2024: A leaflet containing times for Mass, Confessions and other services during Holy Week and Easter Week is available at the back of the Church.

SVP Monthly Collection: The monthly Saint Vincent de Paul Collection will take place outside the Church after Masses this weekend.

Holy Land Collection: At the services on Good Friday, there will be a special collection for the Church in the Holy Land.
