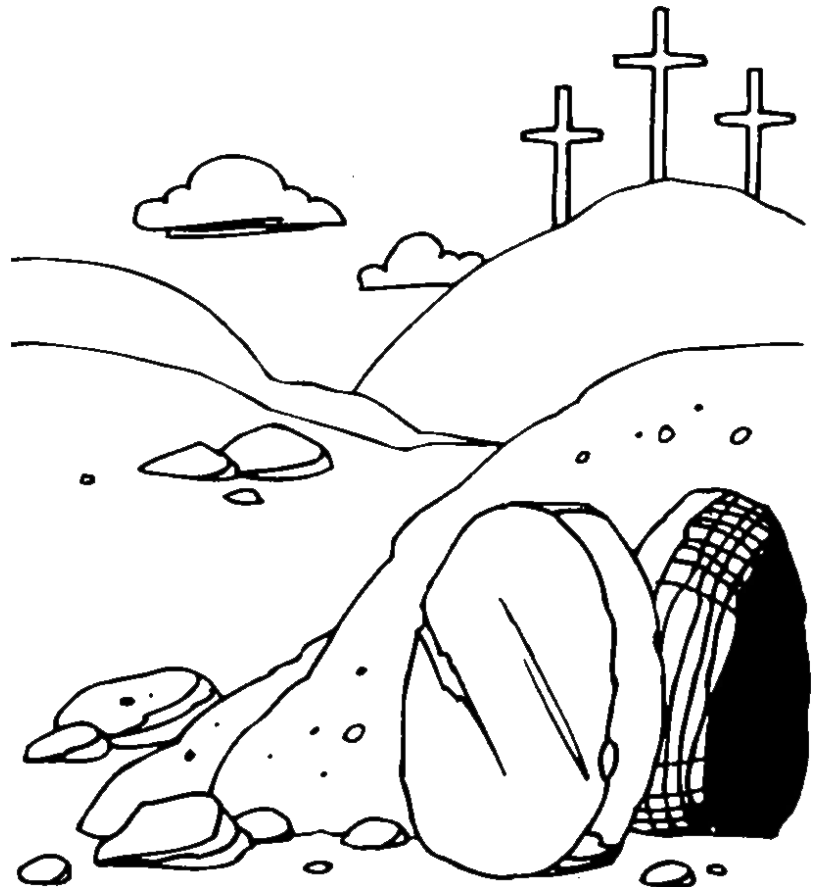

Easter Dues (Half-yearly Dues) can be made via envelopes at the back of the Church, the website and card machines.

Parish Income/Tax Relief

We rely on the continued generosity of our donors as the primary source of income for the Parish and the Community at Mount Argus. If you pay tax, we would ask you to use the parish envelopes, bank transfer, the website and the relevant envelopes (*viz.* Half-year Dues and November Dead List). This will enable us to identify your contributions and allow us to claim back from the Government the tax you have paid (if you contribute €250 or more during the year). This is extra income at no expense to the donor.

We would ask individuals, who have made contributions of €250.00 or more to the Parish, in the last four years to complete the relevant CHY forms to enable us to process a tax relief claim. Please see Fr Aidan.
